3. Fair Access to Care Services (FACS) – A Well-Being Threshold

Report of the Strategic Director – Adult, Health & Community Services

The implementation would be project managed in line with available resources determined through the Council's corporate budget process.

- 1. Note the proposed changes to Fair Access criteria as set out which are designed to enable the Council to develop, in partnership where appropriate, a co-ordinated low intensity support service with special reference to older people; and,
- 2. Consider how it may wish to monitor the development and implementation of new arrangements for low intensity support and advise Cabinet on progress as appropriate; and,
