Improving Performance in respect to Older People Residential Care

Report of the Strategic Director of Adult, Health & Community Services

Recommendation

That the Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee considers and approves the initial response by the Strategic Director of Adult, Health and Community Services, regarding addressing the recommendations to Cabinet as described in the report to the Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 8 November 2006.

1. Background

- 1.1 The Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee meeting of 8 November 2006 heard the Chairs report of the outcomes of the Select Committee into Older People and Residential Care.
- 1.2 The report detailed a number of recommendations to Cabinet in order to improve the quality of care within the local residential care sector through challenging performance and involving partners to inform, develop and support actions to improve performance.
- 1.3 The report also included recommendations to improve performance in respect to the local application of Continuing Health Care and Registered Nursing Care Contributions, again through maximising knowledge, skills and resources available from partners in Health.

2. Response of the Strategic Director of Adult, Health and Community Services to the Recommendations to Cabinet

- 2.1 The Strategic Director of Adult, Health and Community Services is delighted to receive the recommendations to Cabinet as detailed in the report 'Older People and Residential Care' presented to the Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee on the 8 November 2006.
- 2.2 The Strategic Director of Adult, Health and Community Services would like to reassure Members that all recommendations will be effectively addressed to improve performance within the local residential care market in order to



- improve the experience of residents cared for by both independent and inhouse residential care providers.
- 2.3 The Strategic Director is discussing the more strategic issues requiring support and commitment from key partners, notably the Warwickshire PCT, in order to address some of the recommendations. The Acting Head of the Adult Commissioning Unit, Head of Local Commissioning and Head of Local Provider Services similarly are working at early interventions to progress actions to address the recommendations.
- 2.4 Given the timescales it is not achievable to submit a detailed action plan for the Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 13 December, however the Strategic Director will present this action plan at the Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 14 February 2007.
