### Amendment to Indicated Admission Number – Stratford High School

## **Report of the County Education Officer**

#### **Recommendation:**

That the Indicated Admission Number of Stratford High School be increased to 240 pupils per year with effect from September 2006 admissions.

- 1. At its meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> March Cabinet agreed to publish statutory notices regarding its intention to increase the Indicated Admission Number of Stratford High School from 203 pupils per year to 240 pupils per year.
- 2. Statutory notices in respect of the proposal were published on 7<sup>th</sup> April and it is confirmed that, when the notice period expired on 19<sup>th</sup> May, no objections or comments had been received.
- 3. As reported in March, the department has also considered the issue of the 'suitability' of the accommodation at Stratford High School and it was acknowledged that although the school may have a surplus of some rooms, e.g. standard classrooms, it may have a shortage of some specialist rooms, e.g. technology rooms, as the school grows from its current 1,282 pupils on roll to 1,500 pupils on roll. It is confirmed that discussions on the need for some further specialist rooms are continuing between officers and the school.
- 4. The new admission number would apply to Year 7 intake groups as they enter the school from September 2006.
- 5. As there are no objections to the statutory proposals this decision to agree to this prescribed alteration to the school is a matter for decision by Cabinet.
