INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT :

COMMUNITY AND COMMUNITY SPECIAL SCHOOLS

- 1. The name of the school is **Kingsbury Primary School.**
- 2. The school is a Community school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is The Governing Body of Kingsbury Primary School.
- 4. The governing body shall consist of :
 - 5 Parent governors
 - 3 LEA governors
 - 4 Staff governors (including the Headteacher)
 - 3 Community governors
- 5. The total number of governors will be **15.**
- 6. This Instrument comes into effect on 1st September 2005.
- This Instrument was made by order of Warwickshire Local Education Authority on 23rd June 2005.
- 8. A copy of this Instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the Headteacher if not a governor).
