# Warwickshire County Council Implementing Electronic Government Return 2005 Mid Term (IEG 4.5)

### Report of the Director of Contract and Management Services

#### Recommendation

The Cabinet is asked to delegate formal responsibility to the Director of Contract and Management Services to produce and submit the IEG 4.5 return in consultation with the Leaders Liaison Group by 18<sup>th</sup> July.

- 1. As part of the national e-Government Initiative, local authorities have been required to produce Implementing e-Government (IEG) Statements on an annual basis, reporting progress towards the targets set by the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister. Warwickshire County Council statements have always been accepted by the ODPM and as a consequence been rewarded with £900,000 of Local Government On-Line funding.
- 2. As the e-Government deadlines of December 2005 and March 2006 draw nearer, the ODPM is increasing the reporting frequency. Authorities have now been asked to produce a mid term report (IEG 4.5) for July 18<sup>th</sup> 2005, and will be requesting further reports in December 2005 and March 2006.
- 3. In view of :-
  - The timescale pressures to produce the July 18<sup>th</sup> report within Cabinet paper deadlines
  - The fact that this is a mid term progress report with no additional funding associated with it, and
  - We are on track to achieve the ODPM targets/requirements

Cabinet is asked to delegate responsibility to the Director of Contract and Management Services to produce and submit the IEG 4.5 return in consultation with the Leaders Liaison Group by 18<sup>th</sup> July.
