Constitution of a temporary governing body for the new Community Special School in North Warwickshire

Report of the County Education Officer

Recommendation:

That the Cabinet approves the arrangements described in the County Education Officer's report for the constitution of a temporary governing body for the new Community Special School in North Warwickshire.

- 1. Following Cabinet approval of the LEA proposal to close Blythe and Sparrowdale Special Schools and establish a new Community Special School for North Warwickshire, the School Organisation Committee approved this proposal at its meeting on 10th February 2005.
- 2. The New Schools (General) (England) Regulations 2003 provide for the establishment of a temporary governing body for the new school.
- 3. The governors of the existing schools also wish to have a forum established as soon as possible within which issues relating to the new school can be jointly considered by representatives of both schools.
- 4. It is suggested that arrangements should be made to establish a temporary governing body for the new Community Special School from 1st August 2005. The constitution of the temporary governing body will be in accordance with Part 4 of the New Schools (General) (England) Regulations 2003 and will be as follows:
 - 6 Parent governors (to be appointed by the Regulatory Committee taking account of recommendations made by the existing governing bodies)
 - 2 Staff governors (to be appointed by the other temporary governors at their first meeting)
 - 4 LEA governors (to be appointed by the Regulatory Committee)



- 4 Community governors (to be appointed by the Regulatory Committee taking account of recommendations made by the existing governing bodies)
- Head Designate (when appointed)
- Total number of governors : 17.
