Developer Funded Minor Road Schemes

**Report of the Director of Planning, Transport and
Economic Strategy**

Recommendation

That a programme of developer funded minor road schemes to a value of £200,000 be added to the 2005-06 Transport Capital Programme.

1. Developer Funded Minor Road Schemes

Currently, each developer funded road scheme is presented to Cabinet in an individual report regardless of the value of the scheme. The Authority's maximum limit for schemes to be contained within block allocations is £100,000. It is therefore proposed to establish a pre-approved Minor Developer Schemes block allocation. Developer funded schemes, each costing less than £100,000 would be added to the programme, throughout the year, as and when they are identified. The value of this Minor Developer Schemes programme for 2005-06 to be £400,000.
