## Report of the Chair, Adult and Community Services O&S

# Recommendation of the Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee:

That the Cabinet agree the disposal of items from the Museums Collection in accordance with the schedule in Appendix 1 to the report.

# 1. Views of the Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee

The Adult and Community Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee considered the report of the Director of Libraries, Heritage and Trading Standards introducing a recent Museums Association publication, 'Collections for the Future' and presenting the response of the Warwickshire Museums Service and asking Members to make a recommendation to the Cabinet on the disposal of listed items within the collection.

During the ensuing discussion the following points were raised:

- 1. Guidelines for disposals required a formal process to take place, which was important to retain the goodwill and trust of donors.
- 2. Items to be disposed were required to be offered to other museums and on the rare occasion when monies were received from the sale of items, this money was ringfenced into the acquisition fund.
- 3. Members agreed that where items in the collection were in a poor state and were irrepairable, they should be released.
- 4, Members were informed that the Museum Service had still not been able to achieve funding for a computerised Collections Management System and a bid for this system had been included in the budget round.
- 5. Officers were thanked for their work in this area, in particular with the collection at Alcester.

#### Members agreed to:

1. endorse the approach taken by the Museum Service to the issues raised in the Museum Association Publication 'Collections for the Future'.



2. Recommend to Cabinet the disposal of items from the Museums Collection in accordance with the schedule in Appendix 1 to the report.

### 2. Recommendations for Disposal

Following thorough review (and repacking) of part of the costume collection, disposal of the items listed in Appendix 1 is recommended. For each item, a reason for disposal is listed. Disposal will be carried out in accordance with the policy; suitable items will be transferred to Heritage Education for use in handling sessions; other items will be offered to other museums through the Museums Journal in accordance with national recommendations. The relevant section of the Acquisition and Disposal Policy approved by members in 2004 reads as follows:

- 9.8 A decision to dispose of a specimen or object, whether by exchange, sale, gift or destruction (in the case of an item too badly damaged or deteriorated to be of any use for the purposes of the collections), will be the responsibility of the governing body of the museum acting on the advice of professional curatorial staff, if any, and not of the curator of the collection standing alone.
- 9.9 Full records will be kept of all decisions on disposals and the items involved and proper arrangements made for the preservation and/or transfer, as appropriate, of the documentation relating to the items concerned, including photographic records where practicable in accordance with SPECTRUM Procedure 19: Deaccession & disposal.
