Nuneaton Academy – Project Support Funding

Report of the Strategic Director for Children, Young People and Families

Recommendation

That the Cabinet considers approval of the new project support grant of £150,000, available for the Nuneaton Academy, as an addition to the Capital Programme.

1. Background

1.1 The Nuneaton Academy opened on 1 September 2010. The first capital allocation made by Department for Education to establish the Nuneaton Academy within the existing buildings was added to the capital programme in the report presented to Cabinet on 17 June 2010.

2. Update

- 2.1 In August 2010, the Department for Education confirmed they were reviewing funding for academy projects where capital plans were still at a relatively early stage. The plans for the Nuneaton Academy fell into this category.
- 2.2 At the end of December, the Department for Education confirmed the revised capital grant allocation for the Nuneaton Academy to be £9,853,197. A further report outlining the plans for this main capital allocation will be brought to Council later in the year.

3. New Funding Allocation

3.1 To aid with the initial project design costs, part of the overall allocation will be paid up front as project support funding. An initial sum of £150,000 will be paid with the possibility of a further £150,000. Some of this allocation will be spent in 2010/11; the rest will fall into 2011/12. Approval is sought to add this sum to the capital programme.

4. Conclusion

4.1 That the Cabinet considers the approval of the new project support grant of £150,000, available for the Nuneaton Academy, as an addition to the Capital Programme.
