


• Warwickshire

- 2003/2004 Warwickshire recycling rate 14.1%
- Combined recycling and composting rate of 27.7%.
- Joint Municipal Waste Management Strategy adopted in 2005
 - To provide a framework for next 15 years
 - Sets target of a county-wide recycling rate of 40-45% in 2009/2010
 Crecycle for Warwickshire

 Warwickshire's Waste Minimisation Strategy adopted 2007


- To provide a framework for next seven years
- Set a target of a county-wide waste reduction rate of 9.8% by 2014/2015




- Recycling and composting: 48%
- Total recycling, compositing and reuse increased to 101,247 tonnes
- Waste reduction in 2009/10: 2.31%
- 109,000 tonnes of waste sent to Landfill
- ✤ 50,000 tonnes of waste goes to Cov & Solihull EfW
- 5,000 tonnes used for Refuse Derived Fuel (Cemex)

Waste Strategy Checklist

Reduce the amount of waste produced

Exceed 2010 statutory recycling target of 30%

Achieve recycling target of 40-45% by 2009/10

Reduce waste going to landfill

Treat residual waste using thermal treatment system

recycle for Warwickshire

What is currently in place for residual waste?

- 50,000 tonnes of residual waste sent to current EfW facility at Coventry until 2015/16 or 2017/18 including the two year extension;
- 5,000 tonnes of residual waste sent to Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) facility until 2014/15
- 35,000 sent to W2R from 2014/5
- Capacity at Bubbenhall landfill until possibly 2025
- End of other current landfill contracts from 2012/13 (possible two year contract extension option available)



What do we need to do!

- Reduce the amount of waste we produce
- Recycle as much as we can
- Reduce what is sent to landfill
- Work more closely with our Collection Authorities
- Work more closely with our Sub Regional Partners



Where do we want to be?

- Recycling rate of 60% by 2015/16
- Recycling rate of 67% by 2027/8
- Street sweeping recycling 10,000 tonnes from 2012
- 35,000 tonnes sent to W2R from 2014/5
- 30,800 tonnes into Bubbenhall landfill 2015/6
- 53,000 tonnes to treat by means other than landfill by 2016/17
