Warwickshire Police and Crime Annual Report 2014/15

Recommendations

That Council considers and comments on the work achieved by Warwickshire Police and Crime Panel throughout 2014/15.

1.0 Summary

- 1.1 The Warwickshire Police and Crime Panel was appointed in November 2012 to monitor and support the work of the Police and Crime Commissioner. The Commissioner is required to consult with the Panel on his plans for policing, as well as the precept (the money collected from council tax for policing) and certain key appointments.
