Appointments to Committees and Other Bodies

Recommendations:

- (1) That Council confirms the Committee structure and delegations to member bodies and officers as set out in the Constitution (subject to any amendments proposed and agreed at this meeting):
- (2) That Council agrees the appointment of members to the Committees and other bodies as set out in Appendix A (subject to any amendments).
- (3) That the Council authorises the Strategic Director of Resources to make such amendments to the Council's Constitution as may be required as a consequence of any changes agreed by Council.

1.0 Establishment of Committees

1.1 Article 5 of the Constitution requires, as a minimum, the establishment of the following bodies:

Cabinet (appointed by the Leader).
Overview and Scrutiny Committee (at least one)
Audit and Standards Committee
Regulatory Committee
Staff and Pensions Committee (The Leader of the Council Chairs)

The Council currently has four Overview and Scrutiny Committees:

Adult Social Care and Health O&S Committee Children, Young People & Families O&S Committee Communities O&S Committee Corporate Services O&S Committee

2.0 Allocation of seats between political groups

2.1 The composition of the Council is 26 Conservative Group; 22 Labour Group; 9 Liberal Democrat Group; 3 Independent Group and 2 Green Group.

The Local Government and Housing Act 1989 requires that appointments to committees and sub-committees must achieve political balance in their



membership. (There are exceptions to this notably for geographically based committees on which all local members sit).

2.2 The other ground rules are:

Committees: the aggregate allocation of all committee seats must be proportional to the party groups' overall membership on the Council. Within those allocations each individual committee must be split as close to the overall proportions as possible.

Sub-committees: the sub-committee is split proportionally – there is no aggregation.

Panels, Working groups: the national rules do not apply but the Council has applied the proportionality rule as a matter of good practice.

- 2.3 The overall rules can be set aside in favour of local arrangements provided this is agreed by the Council with no-one voting against it.
- 2.4 The allocation to committees agreed at the Annual meeting in 2014 is set out below.

2.5 The Council is invited to confirm/make appointments to Committees and other bodies listed in Appendix A. This year this includes the new Local Pension Board, terms of reference for which were approved by Council on 5 February. The Board is established in accordance with The Public Services Pensions Act 2013 with responsibility for assisting the Scheme Manager in securing compliance with all relevant pension's laws, regulations and directions and the Pension Regulator's codes of practice. Council is requested to appoint two members to the Board. Proportionality rules do not apply. The Council is also asked to endorse the appointment of Keith Bray as the independent chair. Interviews for the Chair were held on 29 April and Keith Bray was selected from an extremely strong field of candidates. Keith has extensive experience in local government and in depth knowledge of issues facing the Local Government Pension Scheme. He has a strong national reputation and has advised on the creation and operation of Local



Pension Boards and compilation of the CIPFA guide "Delivering Good Governance in Local Government Pension Funds."

2.6 The Police and Crime Panel is also included in Appendix A but it will be necessary to review the membership in the light of any changes in the number of seats held by each political group across the Warwickshire area following the district and borough elections on 7 May 2015. A suggested recommendation is included in Appendix A that would delegate the Strategic Director of Resources to change the allocation of seats in consultation with Leaders of the political groups.

3.0 Chairs and Vice Chairs

The Leader of the Council Chairs the Staff and Pensions Committee. The Staff and Pensions Committee appoints the Pension Fund Investment Sub-Committee.

The Chairs and Vice-Chairs of other Committees are appointed at the first meeting of each body over the following weeks. The exception is the Audit and Standards Committee which has an independent chair (John Bridgeman). The Council is invited to consider the appointment of the Chair of this Committee.

4.0 Members Allowances Scheme

If there are any proposed changes in the political management structure and responsibilities this may impact on the allowances payable under the member allowances scheme. Therefore members may need to consider whether any changes should be referred to the Independent Remuneration Panel.

5.0 Schemes of Delegation

The Constitution sets out the delegation of powers to member bodies and officers. The Council is invited to confirm these - except in so far as they may be inconsistent with any changes to the arrangements made for the member bodies set out above.
