Health & Wellbeing Board Annual Review 2015/16

Recommendation

That Council endorses the Health & Wellbeing Board Annual Review 2015/16.

1.0 Key Issues

The Health & Wellbeing Board is committed to producing an annual review which summarises activity and achievements over the financial year.

2.0 Options and Proposal

- 2.1 As a strategic body the Health & Wellbeing Board influence a broad range of activity across multiple organisations.
- 2.2 This activity is aligned to the priorities as set out in the Health & Wellbeing Strategy 2014-18, which in turn are informed by the intelligence provided by the Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA).
- 2.3 The Annual Review therefore provides a summary of the Board's work through a series of case studies from multiple agencies, focussing on agenda items and HWB newsletter items during 2015/16.
- 2.4 In 2015/16 a key feature of this work was the Better Together Programme and this is featured alongside the three strategic priorities within the Review.
- 2.5 This year the Review also signposts readers to the greater detail held in a number of related reports and websites, including:
 - CCG Annual Reports
 - Hospital Annual Reports
 - Healthwatch Annual Report
 - Key programmes ie. Better Together and Smart Start
- 2.6 Following consideration and recommended amendments by the Health and Wellbeing Board on 7th September and approval on 9th November, the final review is presented to Council for endorsement.

Following endorsement by Council the Annual Review will be published on the Health & Wellbeing Board website.
