## **Criteria for Casualty Reduction Schemes**

## Report of the Strategic Director for Environment and Economy

#### Recommendation

That the report be noted.

#### 1. Definition

1.1 In this report the term 'accident' has the meaning given to it in Government statistics; that is one occurring on the public highway in which someone is killed or injured and becomes known to the police within 30 days.

#### 2. Introduction

- 2.1 At its September 2006 meeting the Committee decided to review the criteria for Casualty Reduction Schemes.
- 2.2 The Council receives about 1000 requests a year for work for road safety reasons. Table 1 shows the number of casualty reduction schemes implemented in recent years and their total costs.

### 3. Prioritisation

- 3.1 The number of schemes which can be carried out is limited by the budget available so schemes have to be prioritised.
- 3.2 Each year a list is produced giving the sites at which accidents have occurred in the last three calendar years, with the sites with the greatest number of accidents first. Safety Engineering staff investigate these sites in descending order to see if there is a cost effective scheme which could be expected to reduce casualties.
- 3.3 The threshold (or 'cut off point') depends on the budget available. The present budget is sufficient to carry out casualty reduction schemes at some, but not all, of the treatable sites where there have been six or more accidents in the last three calendar years. **Appendix A** lists the 48 sites where there were six or more accidents in the calendar years 2003 to 2005 inclusive.
- 3.4 164 sites had five accidents and 252 sites had four accidents in 2003 to 2005 inclusive. The relationship between the budget available and the threshold is not exact but these figures indicate that to reduce the threshold below six accidents would require a large increase in the present budget.
