Commissioning Intentions

Recommendation

That the Board Members endorse the Commissioning Intentions for 2019/20 of the Clinical Commissioning Groups, Public Health and Adult Social Care to be presented to the Board on 18th September 2018.

1.0 Key Issues

- 1.1 The Commissioning Intentions of the Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs); and Public Health and Social Care in the County Council will be presented to the Health and Wellbeing Board (HWBB) on 18th September 2018.
- 1.2 All CCGs are required to develop and publish commissioning intentions on an annual basis. The 2019/20 intentions are being developed in the context of:
 - Local population health needs as defined by the Joint Strategic Needs Assessments (JSNA); and
 - National Health deliverables for 2019/20, focusing on key performance challenges for the CCGs. Six work programme areas for 2019/20 have been identified: Primary Care, Urgent and Emergency Care, Planned Care, Out of Hospital, Mental Health, and Maternity and Paediatrics.
- 1.3 The Commissioning Intentions for Adult Social Care and Public Health will also be presented at the HWBB for consideration and endorsement.

2.0 Proposal

- 2.1 The HWBB is asked to consider and endorse the Commissioning Intentions to be presented to the Board on 18th September 2018.
