Commissioning Group Decisions

- Given the relatively poor happiness scores in Warwickshire and despite concerns from AD on the robustness of the data, and ND on the scale for the responses, we should scope a project to investigate 'happiness and perceptions of well-being' further.
- In appreciation of the scope and multi-lateral nature of JSNA work, more direction on the ways in which we can fund and resource work is required.
