Item 3 – Proposed Project Prioritisation and Approval

- Data Integration work stream The Work-Streams are covered separately. Status: **GREEN**.
- Communications work stream The Work-Streams are covered separately. Status: **AMBER**.
- Delaying Parenthood in Looked After Children (LAC) project In initiation stage. Status **AMBER** as currently there are no resources allocated to it.
- Child Sexual Exploitation in Warwickshire project In initiation stage. Status **AMBER** as currently there are no resources allocated to it.

- RR will take any approved projects to PH for consideration for trainee PH consultant resourcing.
- GW is to ensure he includes information from housing partners in the *Impact of the Welfare Reforms Assessment*.
