# Report of the Strategic Director for Environment and Economy

#### Recommendation

That this project be included in the 2010/2011 Capital Programme at a total estimated cost of £330,000, subject to the Section 278 Agreement being signed with Whitbread Group Plc.

#### 1. Background

1.1 Whitbread were given planning permission in December 2007 for the extension and alteration of the existing College House building together with a change of use to a hotel.

#### 2. The Section 278 Works

- 2.1 The planning conditions for the development requires the highway engineering works to be constructed as detailed on plan 2007/0704/001M (See **Appendix 1**).
- 2.2 A Statutory Consultation for the amendment to the existing pedestrian crossings on the Guild Street/Warwick Road/Bridgefoot junction was carried out in January 2009. At the request of local Members the scope of the scheme was subsequently extended to include the linking and upgrading of the existing pedestrian crossings on the Bridge Street/Bridgefoot junction as shown on Plan SIG/357/01B (See **Appendix 2**). The developer has agreed to fund these additional works as part of the S278.
- 2.4 Subject to approval, the County Council will undertake the works through the LTP Contract at an estimated cost of £330, 000. This will be fully funded by the Developer, Whitbread Group, under a Section 278 Agreement which is due to be signed. Construction is expected to commence before the end of the year.
