2007-8 Capital Programme for Transport - Delegated Budget

Report of the Strategic Director for Environment and Economy

Recommendation

That Area Committee approves the implementation of an additional street lighting scheme in Church Walk, Atherstone from the 2007-8 Capital Programme for Transport, to be funded from the Area Committee's delegated budget of £40,000.

1. Background

- 1.1 The Transport Capital Programme for North Warwickshire was supported by Area Committee on 21 March 2007. £40,000 was delegated to North Warwickshire Area Committee to allocate to transport projects which address local priorities.
- 1.2 At the Area Committee meeting on 23 May 2007, Members agreed to implement schemes at Rectory Road, Arley and Merevale Road, Atherstone and Boot Hill, Grendon, from the £40,000 delegated budget. There is currently £6,000 of unallocated funding available from this budget in 2007-08.

2. Additional Street Lighting Church Walk, Atherstone

- 2.1 Church Walk is a well used 'dark alley' and in the past has suffered from overgrown trees. These trees have now been cleared and an assessment made by the County Council's Street Lighting Department. It is proposed to erect five new columns to improve safety and security during the hours of darkness. The estimated cost of the scheme is £6,000.
- 2.2 It is proposed that the remaining £6,000 in the delegated budget which is currently unallocated can be used to fund the additional street lighting scheme in Church Walk, Atherstone.



3. Conclusions

3.1 The table below shows the schemes that are proposed to be funded from Area Committee's delegated budget of £40,000 from the 2007-8 Capital Programme for Transport:-
