Proposed Amendment to Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council's Off-Street Parking Places Order

Report of the Director of Planning, Transport and Economic Strategy

Recommendation

That Nuneaton and Bedworth Area Committee approves the proposed amendment to Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council's Off-Street Parking Order to incorporate the new Justice Walk Car Park.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council is proposing to vary the existing Off-Street Parking Places Order to incorporate the new Justice Walk Car Park in Nuneaton. Under Section 39(3) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, the Borough Council requires consent from the County Council for the proposed change. The purpose of this report is to inform Members of the amendment and seek their approval.

2. Background

- 2.1 As requested by Area Committee Members at their meeting on 15th June 2005, a letter was sent to Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council on 20th June 2005 encouraging them to make the car park available for public use in advance of the item being considered by Area Committee on 27th July 2005. An email response was received from the Borough on 22nd June stating that the car park would be open from 1st July 2005.

3. Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council Proposals

- 3.1 The proposed amendment to the Off-Street Parking Places Order is the addition of the Justice Walk Car Park, Nuneaton. This car park is bounded by Vicarage Street to the east, Wheat Street to the north and Justice Walk to the west.
- 3.2 The car park will be designated as a short stay car park and has 110 spaces. Pricing is as set out for short stay car parks in Nuneaton and Bedworth's Off-Street Parking places (Schedule 1, Part 1 – Group A).

4. Comments and Recommendations

- 4.1 The incorporation of the new Justice Walk Car Park in the Off-Street Parking Places Order and its designation as a short stay car park is consistent with the aims and objectives of the Local Transport Plan 2000. In particular, its designation as a short stay car park will help ensure that there is sufficient short stay parking available to enable Nuneaton to remain competitive, in accordance with Local Transport Plan parking policies.
- 4.2 It is therefore recommended that Nuneaton and Bedworth Area Committee approves the proposed change to Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council's Off-Street Parking Order.
