4. Berrington Road, Camp Hill Road and Craddock Drive, Nuneaton – Proposed Prohibition of Waiting.

Report of the Strategic Director for Environment and Economy.

Proposals for double yellow lines on parts of Berrington Road, Camphill Road and Craddock Drive, Nuneaton were advertised to deal with parking and obstruction problems caused by patients at a dentists surgery. Objections to the parking restrictions were received. The report recommends that the double yellow lines are provided as advertised, except that on part of Craddock Drive these are replaced by single yellow lines to allow evening and weekend parking for customers of local shops.
