#### 1. Introduction

1.1 The Social Inclusion Fund 2007/08 balance is currently £37,475

### 2.0 Priorities Identified by the Funding Sub-Group

- 2.1 The Funding Sub Group recommends that support of £5,000 be made available to the Voluntary Sector Consortium to enable the current Project Manager and Administrator to continue in post, to complete the detailed submissions for Advantage West Midlands Regeneration Zone Funding.
- 2.2 The project is at a critical stage in development, all necessary work to enable a contract to be let, is complete, except for securing the funding to build. The Voluntary Sector Consortium Trust's full application to Advantage West Midlands for Regeneration Zone funding has been approved by Coventry Solihull and Warwickshire Partnership, and is now awaiting AWM Appraisal, planned for early December.

## 3.0 Conclusion

3.1 The remaining balance for Social Inclusion for 2007/08 after this project have been approved would be £32,475.
