Developing the Corporate Business Plan 2009-12

Report of the Strategic Director, Performance & Development

Recommendation

The Overview & Scrutiny Coordinating Group are recommended to:

- Note the process for the development of the 2009-12 Corporate Business Plan and the role of the Overview & Scrutiny Committees in January 2009
- Identify any additional support to OSCs needed to aid the process

1 Introduction

- 1.1 On 31st July 2008 Cabinet agreed the process and timetable for preparing the 2009/10 Budget, Corporate Business Plan (CBP) and Medium Term Financial Plan (MTFP).
- 1.2 This report is designed to outline the key role which the County Council's Overview & Scrutiny function will play in scrutinising the proposed content of the CBP.

2.0 Summary of approach

- 2.1 The Budget and Medium Term Financial Plan are intrinsically linked to the Corporate Business Plan. Together they provide a focus to the delivery of sustainable and improving services for the citizens of Warwickshire.
- 2.2 We continue to be committed to maximising the integration of our financial and service planning, and delivering a business-led budget, as set out in the two elements below:
 - **1. The Corporate Business Plan -** Identifies where we are going by agreeing the vision and priorities for 2009 2012 and how we will know we have got there
 - 2. The Budget and Medium Term Financial Plan Puts the resources in place to allow us to move towards the Vision



2.3 This process is set out in more detail in **Appendix A**. This year both the Budget and the Corporate Business Plan will be agreed at the February 2009 Council meeting.

3.0 The Role of Overview & Scrutiny in the development of the CBP

- 3.1 In 2007/08 the draft Corporate Business Plan was, for the first time presented to each Overview & Scrutiny Committee for consideration prior to submission to Full Council.
- 3.2 Council then agreed to . . 'ensure that the Overview and Scrutiny Committees and the Council will have an opportunity to agree the draft Corporate Business Plan before the budget is set in future years.'
- 3.3 The approach for this year, is that all Overview & Scrutiny Committees will consider the draft Corporate Business Plan after it has been agreed in draft form alongside the Budget by Cabinet on 11th December. This will occur before it is considered by Full Council on 3rd February 2009.
 - **NB.** This process compliments the Overview & Scrutiny Coordinating Group's consideration of the draft Budget on 18th December 2008.
- 3.4 Whilst trying to minimise disruption to existing schedules, the relevant Committees have been scheduled as follows:

Mon 5 th Jan	Economic Development O&S
Tues 6 th Jan	Community Protection
Wed 7 th Jan	Children, Young & Families People O&S
Tues 13 th Jan	Resources, Performance & Development O&S
Wed 14 th Jan	Adult & Community services O&S
TBC	Environment O&S

- 3.5 The Corporate Business Plan will be produced in two distinct parts, the first providing contextual and background information based upon environmental scanning at a national, local and organisational level. The second part will focus on delivery of the Corporate priorities. At each meeting the O & S Committees will be asked to:
 - Comment on the overall Plan and provide specific feedback on the contextual elements and references
 - Challenge and scrutinise the specific targets set under the area of the Plan which relate most closely to the remit of the respective Committee

Feedback will then be consolidated into an Addendum, which will be presented at Full Council alongside the proposed draft of the Corporate Business Plan.

3.6 To support each Committee in this process the respective Portfolio Holder will be invited to attend the O & S meeting and present the proposed content.

3.7 To ensure that the consultation exercise is an effective as possible, the Overview & Scrutiny Coordinating Group are asked to consider whether any further support should be provided to each Committee.

4.0 Recommendations

- 4.1 The Overview & Scrutiny Coordinating Group is recommended to:
 - Note the process for the development of the 2009-12 Corporate Business Plan and the role of the Overview & Scrutiny Committees in January 2009
 - Identify any additional support to OSCs needed to aid the process.
