# **Changes in Membership to the Pension Fund**

# **Report of the County Treasurer**

### Recommendation

That the Board note the report.

#### 1 Introduction

- 1.1 There have been several movements in membership of the Pension Fund, with members both leaving and joining the scheme.
- 1.2 The changes are summarised below:

## **2 Significant Movements of Scheme Members**

#### **Grounds Maintenance Service**

- 2.1 The Grounds Maintenance Service was outsourced by the County Council to Cleanaway Services Ltd with effect from 1 April 2005.

  Although the new employer was offered the opportunity of Admitted Body status within the Warwickshire County Council Pension Fund, they were unable to provide the necessary guarantees required.
- 2.2 As an alternative, Cleanaway Services Ltd has provided a comparable pension scheme for the 21 scheme members affected by the transfer.

## **Magistrates Courts Service**

- 2.3 Following a national reorganisation of the Magistrates Courts Service, 74 scheme members have transferred to the Principal Civil Service Pension Scheme with effect from 1 April 2005. There are ongoing negotiations between representatives of the Local Authority funds and the Government Actuary's Department concerning the calculation of funds to be transferred.
- 2.4 The County Treasurer will update members of the outcome of these negotiations at a future meeting



### **Town and Parish Councils**

2.5 The following Town and Parish Councils have recently passed resolutions for their employees to have access to the Local Government Pension Scheme:

Southam Town Council Bidford-on-Avon Parish Council Ryton-on-Dunsmore Parish Council
