Charity Initiative – "Pennies from Heaven"

Report of the Strategic Director of Resources

Recommendation

That the Board agree to the promotion of the "Pennies from Heaven" scheme to retired members of the Warwickshire County Council Pension Fund at a future date to be decided.

1. Introduction

1.1 "Pennies from Heaven" is a simple scheme whereby employees and retired staff members are invited to donate the spare pennies from their monthly salary or pension to charity.

2. How the Scheme works

- 2.1 The scheme works by deducting the spare pennies from a monthly payment of salary or pension. For example, if a monthly pension payment is £280.17, then the 'spare' 17p is deducted (with the prior agreement of the pensioner) from the pension and set aside for charitable use. The monthly amounts donated will vary each month, but will never exceed 99p.
- 2.2 The donations are treated as Gift Aid, resulting in the nominated charities being able to reclaim the basic rate tax on donations. This adds a further 28% to the value of the donations.
- 2.3 The County Council is currently offering this scheme to employees with donations raised being shared equally between the Myton Hospice in Warwick and the Mary Ann Evans Hospice in Nuneaton.

3. Communication of the Scheme

3.1 In the latest edition of the Ragged Staff, the Pension Services Group canvassed the retired members about the possible introduction of such a scheme and I am pleased to inform the Board that there were no dissenters out of all the responses received.



3.2 The Board will be aware that the payroll for retired members has been moved from Unipay to Oracle and I propose, therefore, to launch the "Pennies from Heaven" scheme once we are satisfied that the Oracle system has been "bedded in" sufficiently.

4. Recommendation

4.1 That the Investment Board agree to the promotion of the "Pennies from Heaven" scheme to retired members of the Warwickshire County Council Pension Fund at a future date to be decided.
