

Decision Record – Addition of one Developer-funded Highway Scheme to the Capital Programme – Shottery Bus Stop

Decision Taken

That the Deputy Leader (Portfolio Holder for Finance and Property) gives approval to add the following scheme to the Capital Programme for 2017-18:

Upgrading of Existing Bus Stop Infrastructure on Alcester Road (Shottery) in Stratford upon Avon, at an approximate cost of £14,000 fully funded from a developer contribution.

Reasons for Decisions

On 23 May 2017, the Council reconfirmed the delegated power to the Leader, or body nominated by them, to approve the addition to the capital programme of schemes costing less than £2.0 million, which are fully funded from external grants, developer contributions or from revenue. The Deputy Leader (Finance and Property) is that nominated body.

Background Information

A planning application was submitted to Stratford on Avon District Council in regard to the development of land at Alcester Road, Shottery in Stratford upon Avon. Planning permission was granted on 19 January 2016 (Planning Application ref No. 15/03408/FUL) and this requires the Developer to make a financial contribution of £14k to the County Council prior to occupation of the first dwelling, towards the upgrading of existing local bus service infrastructure.

The funding has been earmarked to formalise and enhance the pair of unmarked bus stops on Alcester Road near the junction with The Ridgway, situated in the vicinity of the new development. County Council officers will consult with the local WCC Member in order to obtain a steer on the extent of the works.
