It is the County Council's practice that all fees and charges are increased each year by at least the rate of inflation. In calculating charges for the year 2019/2020, the aim has been to achieve an overall increase in income matching an inflation rate of 2%, except where particular circumstances (need for greater cost recovery, new chargeable activity etc.) warrants a different level of increase or decrease in relation to a specific type of charge.
