Decision Taken

That the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Environment approves the Warwickshire County Council (Long Itchington Village) (30 and 40 mph speed limit) (Variation no.1) Order 2017 (now 2018).

Reasons for Decisions

The Council's Constitution requires that where an objection has been received to an advertised RTO a decision is required of the Portfolio Holder.

Background Information

A new access to a development has been granted planning permission off Marton Road. Although the County Council as highways consultee did not ask for a reduction in the speed limit, the District Council's Planning Committee felt that one should be made and required the developer to sign a planning obligation to fund the cost of making an order.

Formal consultation letters were sent to addresses on Marton Road on 5th October 2017.

It is agreed that the entire length of the existing 40 mph speed limit on Marton Road, Long Itchington is to be replaced with a 30 mph speed limit as shown on the published plan.
