

Decision Record – Various Roads, Stratford-upon-Avon District – Proposed Waiting Restrictions, On-street Parking Places and Residents’ Parking Permits – Variation 02

Decision Taken
That the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Environment approves that the Warwickshire County Council (District Of Stratford On Avon) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents’ Parking) (Consolidation) (Variation 02) Order 2017 be made with the exception of Alcester Road - Studley and Baker Avenue – Stratford-upon-Avon.

Reasons for Decisions
Traffic Orders that have attracted objections during consultation require the approval of the Portfolio Holder.

Background Information
Proposals for waiting restrictions both new and revised along with disabled bays at various locations in Stratford District were advertised in the Stratford Herald on the 16th November 2017 and consultation was carried out in accordance with statutory procedure. It was recommended to withdraw the following proposals due to objections received. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alcester Road, Studley - Revocation of Limited Waiting • Baker Avenue, Stratford-upon-Avon - No Waiting at any Time <p>The following proposals received objections however it was recommended to implement them as advertised.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A435 Slip Road, Aspley Heath - No Waiting at any Time • Main Street, Tiddington - Limited Waiting • Station Road, Studley - Revocation of No Waiting <p>A number of other proposals were included in the advertisements but received no objections. It was therefore recommended that those proposals be implemented as advertised.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masons Road, Stratford-upon-Avon - Disabled Badge Holders Only • Saffron Meadow, Stratford-upon-Avon - No Waiting at any Time • Station Road, Long Marston - Revocation of NWAAT
