

**Decision Record – Nuneaton and Bedworth  
Off-Street Parking Places (No 2) Order 2013**

#### Decision Taken

That I, as Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning, consent to the making of the Nuneaton and Bedworth Off-Street Parking Places Order 2013.

#### Reasons for Decisions

NBBC is proposing to introduce the following new charges (existing charges shown in brackets [ ]:-

- i) Short Stay season tickets in all charging car parks
- For a period of one year                      £700                      [£655]
  - For a period of 6 months                      £375                      [£350]
  - For a period of up to one month              £85                      [£80]
- ii) Long Stay season tickets for use in Long Stay and designated car parks:-
- For a period of one year                      £460                      [£425]
  - For a period of 6 months                      £265                      [£245]
  - For a period of up to one month              £65

It is not expected that the introduction of charges will result in a significant impact on-street but the situation will be monitored and appropriate mitigation measures will be considered if necessary.

#### Background Information

Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council (NBBC) is proposing to introduce changes to its Off-Street Parking Places Order which will result in increased charges for short and long stay season tickets. The County Council's consent is needed for the Order to be made.
