Decision Taken

That I, as Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning, consent to the making of the Stratford-upon-Avon Off-Street Parking Places Order 2013.

Reasons for Decisions

Stratford-upon-Avon District Council is proposing to:-

- i) Extend public opening hours for Church Street car park to cover all weekends and Bank Holidays and from 4pm to 8am on weekdays;
- ii) Rename the following car parks:-

- iii) Introduce pay by phone and credit/debit card payment options;
- iv) Introduce "virtual" permits based around hand held automatic number plate recognition;
- v) Require the display of parking tickets on the dashboard rather than the windscreen; and
- vi) Clarify that it would be a contravention to park a vehicle otherwise than in a bay indicated for the parking of vehicles (with a view to introducing charging points for electric vehicles to be dealt with outside the 2013 Order)..

It is not expected that any of the proposed changes will result in an impact on-street.

Background Information

Stratford-on-Avon District Council (SDC) is proposing to make a new Off-Street Parking Places Order to give effect to various changes agreed by its Cabinet that are designed to improve the off-street parking offer in Stratford-upon-Avon. Some of these changes relating to the rationalisation of parking charges have already been implemented as a variation to the existing Off-Street Parking Places Order and will be incorporated in the new Order. The County Council's consent is needed to the making of a new Order.
