Proposed Decision to be taken by the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning on or after 22 November 2013

Nuneaton and Bedworth Off-Street Parking Places (No 3) Order 2013

Recommendation

That the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning consents to the making of the Nuneaton and Bedworth Off-Street Parking Places Order (No 3) 2013.

1.0 Key Issues

1.1 Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council (NBBC) is proposing to introduce changes to its Off-Street Parking Places Order which will result in a change of use for the Riverside and Town Hall car parks off Mill Street Nuneaton and the inclusion of the residents' car park at Dempster Court, Church Street in the Order.

2.0 Proposals

- 2.1 NBBC is proposing to make the following changes
 - (i) The Town Hall car park to become available for public use at all times. Previously this has been reserved for Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council "barrier pass" holders on Mondays-Fridays until 17:00.
 - (ii) The Riverside car park will be reserved for Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council "designated users" on Mondays-Fridays until 17:00. At other times it will be available to members of the public for a maximum of 2 hours. Previously this has been available as a short 2 hour maximum stay Pay and Display car park at all times.
 - (iii) The Dempster Court car park will become a residents permit holders only car park enforced by Civil Enforcement Officers employed by Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council. Previously this was a private car park enforced by a barrier system.
- 2.2 It is not expected that these changes will have any impact on the on-street parking operation in Nuneaton and Bedworth.

3.0 Financial Implications

3.1 There are no direct financial implications arising from supporting NBBC's proposals.



4.0 Timescales associated with the decision/Next steps

4.1 NBBC is proposing to make the Order to come into force on 1st December 2013.
