

## Decision Record – Nuneaton and Bedworth Off-Street Parking Places (No 3) Order 2013

### Decision Taken

That the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning consents to the making of the Nuneaton and Bedworth Off-Street Parking Places Order (No 3) 2013.

### Reasons for Decisions

Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council (NBBC) is proposing to make the following changes:

- (i) The Town Hall car park to become available for public use at all times. Previously this has been reserved for Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council “barrier pass” holders on Mondays-Fridays until 17:00;
- (ii) The Riverside car park will be reserved for NBBC “designated users” on Mondays-Fridays until 17:00. At other times it will be available to members of the public for a maximum of 2 hours. Previously this has been available as a short 2 hour maximum stay Pay and Display car park at all times.
- (iii) The Dempster Court car park will become a resident’s permit holders only car park enforced by Civil Enforcement Officers employed by NBBC. Previously this was a private car park enforced by a barrier system.

It is not expected that these changes will have any impact on the on-street parking operation in Nuneaton and Bedworth.
