

Decision Record – A4097 Kingsbury Road, Curdworth Prohibition of Stopping on the Footway or Verge

Decision Taken

That the proposed prohibition of stopping on the footway or verge be implemented as advertised.

Reasons for Decisions

A number of HGV's are parking along a section of A4097 Kingsbury Road which is creating an obstruction for motorists, residents, pedestrians and cyclists and compromising road safety.

Concerns to the safety of road users have been raised by the local member, residents and Curdworth Parish Council regarding the HGV parking by Rentacrate delivery vehicles.

Background Information

Consultation has been carried out with the Local Member, Parish Council, Warwickshire Police, Emergency Services, Road Haulage Association, three Members of Birmingham City and other statutory consultees.

Legal notices advertising the proposal was placed in the local paper on the 4th September 2014. Notices were also placed on street, and on the Warwickshire Web pages, letters were hand delivered to businesses in the area.
