# Proposed Decision to be taken by The Cabinet Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning on or after 12 June 2015

# Consultation on the Proposals Associated with Getting West Nuneaton Moving: Bermuda Connection

#### Recommendation

That the Cabinet Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning approves the proposal for consultation as set out in the report.

### 1.0 Key Issues

- 1.1 The Business Case for the Proposed Bermuda Connectivity Project highlights that the proposed scheme would yield a substantial level of benefits. The initial cost of the scheme was stated at £3.7 million.
- 1.2 The County Council, at its meeting on 28 October 2014, approved the allocation of £3.202 million of the WCC Capital Growth fund to part fund the proposed scheme. The County Council was informed that the next steps would include the further development of the preliminary design proposals associated with the scheme and undertaking a consultation with local communities, interest groups and those impacted by the proposals.
- 1.3 In December 2014, Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council bid for a £500k Growing Places Fund Grant contribution towards the cost of the proposed scheme from CWLEP.
- 1.4 The Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning is aware of the proposals that will form the basis of the consultation exercise.

# 2.0 Options and Proposal

- 2.1 In February 2015, the County Council commissioned work to progress further development of the proposed scheme and this form the basis of the consultation.
- 2.2 The consultation will comprise the following four elements:
  - Consultation Information Pamphlet (Local Residents):
     A pamphlet containing consultation material about the proposed scheme will be distributed to approximately 23,000 households in West Nuneaton.
  - Consultation Information Pamphlet (Local Businesses):

A pamphlet containing consultation material about the proposed scheme will be distributed to local businesses in the Nuneaton area. This includes those local businesses which provided the letters of support included in the Business Case.
