

Decision Record – Various Roads, Rugby Borough - Proposed Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents’ Parking Permits – Variation 2

Decision Taken
That the Portfolio Holder for Transport & Planning agrees that “The Warwickshire County Council (Borough Of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Parking Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places And Residents’ Parking) (Consolidation) (Variation No. 2) Order 2018” be made as advertised with the exception of the proposals relating to High Street, Hillmorton.

Reasons for Decisions
Where objections have been received to traffic orders the Portfolio Holder must decide on them.

Background Information
Proposals for waiting restrictions, both new and revised at various locations in Rugby Borough were published in the Rugby Observer on 12 th July 2018 and consultation carried out in accordance with statutory procedure. Objections and comments to the following proposals have been received.
