

Decision Record – Various Roads, Stratford-on-Avon District – Proposed Waiting Restrictions, On-street Parking Places and Residents’ Parking Permits – Variation 04

Decision Taken
That the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning approves that the Warwickshire County Council (District Of Stratford On Avon) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents’ Parking) (Consolidation) (Variation 04) Order 2018 be made as advertised.

Reasons for Decisions
Where objections have been submitted to a traffic order the matter must be considered and decided on by the Portfolio Holder.

Background Information
<p>Proposals for the ‘No Return’ times to be extended on parking bays and disabled bays at various locations in Stratford District to assist with the enforcement of these restrictions were published in the Stratford Observer on 26 July 2018 and consultation was carried out in accordance with statutory procedure. The purpose is to remove the opportunity for drivers whose vehicle is found in the same location after the permitted parking period has expired to claim that they moved it just after the civil enforcement officer (“CEO”) first saw it and returned it shortly before the CEO next saw it.</p> <p>If the No Return period is longer than the permitted parking period, then it can be proven that the vehicle must either have remained parked for longer than the permitted period or have been moved and returned before the end of the No Return period.</p> <p>The following proposals received objections however it is agreed to implement them as advertised:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Maidenhead Road, Stratford- upon – Avon 2 Hrs No Return 4 Hrs Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Except Permit Holders (S2) & (S3) ● Bridge St, Church St, High St, Sheep St & Union St, Stratford-upon-Avon – Disabled Badge Holders Only At All Times, 3 hrs No Return 4 hrs 8am- 6pm <p>A number of other proposals were included in the advertisements but received no objections.</p>
