

## Decision Record – Various Roads, Nuneaton & Bedworth Borough – Proposed Waiting Restrictions, On-street Parking Places, Disabled Parking Places and Loading restrictions – Variation 02

<p><b>Decision Taken</b></p> <p>That the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning approves that:</p> <p>The Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Nuneaton) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) (Variation 02) Order 2018 be made as advertised, with the following exceptions;</p> <p><b>Nuneaton Princes Ave junctions with Bracebridge St &amp; Norman Ave.</b> That these proposals should be withdrawn, pending a whole area review into parking to be carried out on completion of the A444 Coton Arches works and if approved the re-opening of Bermuda Bridge.</p> <p><b>Nuneaton, Pool Bank Street – Proposed 'Loading only Bay'</b> That these proposals be withdrawn, pending further discussions with affected businesses into alternative locations, with further proposals to be advertised at a later date if applicable.</p>

<p><b>Reasons for Decisions</b></p> <p>Approval is required of the Portfolio Holder where a highway scheme has attracted objections.</p>

<p><b>Background Information</b></p> <p>Proposals for waiting restrictions both new and revised along with disabled bays at various locations within the Borough of Nuneaton &amp; Bedworth were published in the local press in Nuneaton, on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2018 and a consultation was carried out in accordance with statutory procedure.</p> <p>The following proposals received objections and comments; these are discussed in sections 2,3 &amp; 4 :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Nuneaton, Princes Avenue junction with Bracebridge Street &amp; Norman Ave. – 'No Waiting at any Time'</b></li> <li>● <b>Nuneaton, Pool Bank Street – Proposed new 'Loading Only Bay'</b></li> <li>● <b>Nuneaton, Jodrell Street,- 29m revocation of 'No Waiting at any Time'</b></li> </ul> <p>A number of other proposals were included in the advertisements but received no objections. It is therefore recommended that those proposals be implemented as advertised.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Nuneaton, Croft Road – Proposed removal of 'No Waiting at any Time'</b></li> <li>● <b>Bulkington, Withybrook Road junction with Shilton lane - Proposed 'No Waiting at any Time'</b></li> <li>● <b>Bedworth, Croft Rd junction with Newtown Rd- Proposed extension of 'No</b></li> </ul>
