Outcome of Consultation School Term and Holiday Dates 2013/14

Recommendation

That the Portfolio Holder approves School Term and Holiday Dates for the 2013/14 academic year as set out below.

1.0 Key Issues

The Local Authority is responsible for setting school term and holiday dates for all Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools. Academies, Foundation, and Aided Schools are responsible for setting their own term dates. No information has yet been received from such schools regarding likely calendars for the 2013/14 academic year.

2.0 Proposal and Consultation

- 2.1 Between 2 February 2012 and 23 March 2012 a consultation exercise was carried out by Warwickshire County Council into possible calendars for the 2013/14 academic year. A copy of the consultation document is attached at **Appendix A.**
- 2.2 Two possible calendars were put forward for consideration. The first of these is based around the calendar suggested by the LGA (Local Government Association), attached as **Appendix B**. The other adheres to the principles traditionally used to devise calendars in Warwickshire, this is attached as **Appendix C**.
- 2.3 Discussions with neighbouring authorities suggest that they are likely to adopt a calendar very similar to that put forward by the LGA.
- 2.4 The traditional Warwickshire calendar has an Easter Break which is a week later than the one suggested by the LGA, with the Easter weekend sitting in the middle of the break. It does, however, allow for an earlier end to the academic year, while the half-term and Christmas breaks align with those suggested by the LGA.
- 2.5 As a result of the consultation exercise, forty two comments were received in response. Eight of these were in favour of a calendar based around the LGA model, while thirty four were in favour of a calendar which adhered to the principles traditionally used to devise calendars in Warwickshire.



- 2.6 While a traditional Warwickshire calendar will lead to an Easter break which would differ to our neighbours, there are a number of other advantages (see above).
- 2.7 It is therefore recommended that the traditional Warwickshire calendar shown at Appendix C of the attached document be adopted for the 2013/14 academic year.

3.0 Timescales associated with the decision/Next steps

- 3.1 The Portfolio Holder is asked to approve the dates as set out in Appendix C.
- 3.2 If approval is given, the dates will then be made available via the Warwickshire County Council website and distributed more widely as appropriate.

Action required:	Comments are invited on the proposed calendars for the 2013/14 academic year and should be submitted by Friday 23 March 2012.							

Introduction

As you know the Local Authority is responsible for setting school term and holiday dates for all Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools. This paper contains details of suggested school term and holiday dates for the 2013/14 academic year. Included are two suggested calendars and we would like to hear your views. After consideration of the comments received, a recommendation will be made to the Portfolio Holder for People Group.

A copy of this paper will be made available to the public via the Warwickshire County Council website, and schools are encouraged to share the proposals with students and their parents. Comments are also invited from professional associations and Warwickshire's Augmented Teachers' Panel (ATP).

Traditional principles used in Warwickshire

I am mindful that when setting school term and holiday dates for Warwickshire schools, a number of 'guiding principles' are used, and every effort is always made to adhere to as many of the following as possible:

- A calendar of 195 days is set from which the five Teacher Days are taken.
- Two of the five Teacher Days are defined by the Local Authority one at the start of the Autumn and Spring terms. The other three are set by schools.
- Friday of August Bank Holiday week is a Teacher Day but, by agreement at school level, staff do not have to attend if they commit to activities at other times. Most schools are therefore closed during this week.
- A three-weekend break at both Christmas and at Easter.
- Summer holiday is near to six weeks as a minimum, if possible.

I am aware that in attempting to adhere to the above principles, Warwickshire's calendars have in recent years, differed to those set by neighbouring authorities. This has led to criticism from schools as well as parents. To that end, I have met with colleagues from the West Midlands Authorities to secure agreement on the proposal of the term time dates.

In setting a calendar for the 2013/14 academic year, our aim is to consult as widely as possible. It should be noted though that a calendar which matches our neighbours does require a compromise in the form of a late end to the academic year. A calendar which adheres to the above principles is possible, but may lead to an Easter Break which is later than in neighbouring authorities.

Options for 2013/14

The Local Government Association has now published a suggested calendar for the 2012/13 academic year. The calendar shown at **Appendix A** is based around the one suggested by the LGA and has the following features:

- A late start to the academic year with no teacher training day during August Bank Holiday week.
- The half-term breaks have been accepted in principle by our neighbouring Local Authorities.
- An eight day break at Christmas.
- An eleven day Easter Break with a return the day after Easter Monday.
- An academic year which finishes late in July and mid-week.

Appendix A School Term and Holiday Dates 2013 14.doc

An alternative to the above calendar is shown at **Appendix B** which is the preferred option. This adheres to all of the key principles we traditionally try to accommodate, but requires an earlier, and shorter break at Easter. The key features are as follows:

- Term dates are set for complete weeks in the main no split start and end weeks.
- No teaching during August Bank Holiday week.
- Two Teacher Days set by the Local Authority (Friday 30 August 2013 and Monday 06 January 2014). Schools would be free to disaggregate the first of these days.
- Half-terms in line with those suggested by the LGA, and which have been adopted by our neighbours.
- A ten-day Easter Break, but one week earlier than that set by the LGA, and therefore likely to differ from our neighbours.
- The academic year ends on a Friday and allows for a six week summer break.

Next steps

Comments should be submitted by Friday 23 March 2012.

All comments received will be considered before a recommendation is put forward to the relevant Portfolio Holder. The calendar for the 2013/14 academic year will then be published in late May.
