Instrument of Government for the New St. Marie's Catholic Primary School and Nursery Opening in September 2011

Recommendations

That the Portfolio Holders approve the draft Instrument of Government for the new Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School and Nursery in Rugby, to be known as St. Marie's Catholic Primary School and Nursery, opening in September 2011, attached as Appendix A to this report.

1. Background

- 1.1 The School Governance (New Schools) (England) Regulations 2007 require the Local Authority to ensure that an Instrument of Government has been made for a new school in accordance with regulations 29 to 31 of The School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2007 before the school opening date.
