Development at former Cattle Market Site, Alcester Road, Stratford (Developer Funded Scheme)

Recommendation

That the project to provide the necessary road improvements agreed as part of the planning conditions for the development at the Former Cattle Market Site in Stratford be included in the 2011/12 capital programme at an estimated cost of £1,070,000 subject to a Section 278 Agreement which provides for 100% funding of the project being signed with the developer.

1. Introduction

1.1 On 15 February 2011 Council reconfirmed the delegated power to the Leader, or body nominated by him, to approve the addition to the capital programme of projects costing less than £1.5 million, which are fully funded from external grants, developer contributions or from revenue.

2. Description of the Development

- 2.1 The site of the Former Cattle Market in Stratford is to be developed by Redrow Homes and will consist of approximately 200 residential units plus some retail units. A bus / rail interchange is also included in the development with associated public realm works (shelters, toilets, seating, pedestrian and cycle links) and additional car parking for Stratford railway station.
- 2.2 There are extensive roadworks required in order to facilitate the development. These include a new traffic signal control junction on Alcester Road to provide the main access to the development but the planning conditions also require improvements on Birmingham Road and Arden Street which also connect to the development. There is a map showing the site referred to in **Appendix A**.
- 2.2 Subject to Portfolio Holder approval, the County Council will undertake the works at an estimated cost of £1,070,000 including fees, to be funded by the developer Redrow Homes, under a Section 278 agreement. Tenders are expected to be received in September 2011 and, subject to the signing of the S278 agreement, works can commence shortly afterwards.
