Decision taken

That I, as Portfolio Holder for Finance, Improvement and IT, approves the following:

- 1) To add the scheme for a proposed Gating Order on Faraday Avenue, Coleshill, at a value of £220,000 and funded by the Hams Hall BID (Business Improvement District) Company, to the Capital Programme for Transport and Highways for the current and next financial years; and
- 2) The addition to the Capital Programme for Transport and Highways, of upgrades of various traffic signal junctions and Pelican crossing sites at a value of £204,000. The works can be financed in 2012/13 from existing third party funding.

Reasons for Decisions

Gating Order in Faraday Avenue, Coleshill, Warwickshire

The Hams Hall BID Company is providing funding to implement a Gating Order in Faraday Avenue, Coleshill.

The sole purpose of the Order is to provide control over crime and behaviour which has caused harassment, alarm and distress (“anti-social behaviour”), on Faraday Avenue.

The road has been used for “cruising” consisting of random parades at which customised vehicles are paraded and raced. These events are organised by communications through social media and can occur at short notice at any time of the day or night.

Upgrading Traffic Signal Junctions and Pedestrian Crossings

It is proposed to upgrade various traffic signal junctions and pedestrian crossings within the County where the existing sites have reached the end of their life cycle. The works to be funded from existing third party funding.
