#### Report of the Strategic Director for Children, Young People and Families

##### **Recommendation:**

That the three Local Authority governor seats on the governing body for the new Woodlands Community Special School be allocated as follows:

Conservative Group	:	2 seats
Labour Group	:	1 seat.

##### **Allocation of new Local Authority (LA) governor seats on the governing body for the new Woodlands Community Special School**

1. The new Woodlands Community Special School opened in April 2006. The Instrument of Government for this new school was approved by Cabinet on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2006 and the permanent governing body will be constituted by the end of the Summer Term 2006.
2. There are three LA governor seats on the permanent governing body. The informal member panel, set up by Regulatory Committee to consider appointments to school governing bodies, recommends that these three LA governor seats are allocated as follows:

2 seats	:	Conservative Group
1 seat	:	Labour Group.
3. The Committee is recommended to allocate the seats accordingly.
