Appointment to School Governing Bodies

Report of the Strategic Director for Children, Young People and Families

Recommendations:

(1) That the three Local Authority governor seats on the temporary governing body for the proposed new Community Primary School in Rugby be allocated as follows:

Conservative Group : 1 seat Labour Group : 1 seat Liberal Democrat Group : 1 seat

(2) That the Strategic Director for Children, Young People and Families be authorised to approve the appointment of four Parent governors and three Community governors to the temporary governing body for the proposed new Community Primary School in Rugby.

Temporary governing body for the proposed new Community Primary School in Rugby

1.1 At its meeting on 21st July 2005, the Cabinet authorised the establishment of a temporary governing body for the proposed new Community Primary School in Rugby opening in September 2007, following the closure of Rokeby Infant and Junior Schools.

The adopted policy is to consider the Local Authority (LA) governor seats on temporary governing bodies as a separate group from permanent governing bodies.

1.2 **LA governor seats on the temporary governing body**: there are three LA governor seats required on the temporary governing body and the informal member panel, set up by Regulatory Committee to consider appointments to school governing bodies, is recommending that these three LA governor seats be allocated as follows:

1 seat **Conservative Group**

Labour Group 1 seat

1 seat Liberal Democrat Group

1.3 Parent governors and Community governors on the temporary governing body: there are four parent governor appointments and three community governor appointments to be made to the temporary governing body.

In order to maintain continuity and enable experienced governors to serve on the temporary governing body, it is recommended that nominations are invited from the governing bodies of the two schools, which are to be discontinued, and that the Strategic Director for Children, Young People and Families be authorised to make these appointments (subject to any contentious issues being referred back to the Regulatory Committee).
