3.0 Summaries of the Electoral Divisional Panel Meetings between 26 April 2006 and 29 June 2006

3.1 Brownsover (Newbold Community Forum), 22 May 2006 at Newbold Riverside Primary School, Rugby

Attendance: 8

The meeting discussed policing matters in the area and an update was given on the Rugby Western Relief Road.

3.2 Brownsover (Benn Community Forum), 24 May 2006 at Parents Centre, Rugby and 7th June 2006 at Benn Partnership Centre

Attendance: 50+

The Panel discussed the proposed relocation of the Positive Operational Drop-In (POD) for young people from the Cattle Market to the Millennium Green and issues relating to Anti Social Behaviour.

The meeting discussed the redevelopment plans for Boughton Road and Leicester Road. Residents' concerns largely related to traffic issues.
