1.0 Introduction

1.1 This report updates Rugby Area Committee on issues which have been discussed at recent Electoral Divisional & Locality Panel meetings, and provides a timetable of future meetings.

2.0 Key actions agreed at meetings:

2.1 Earl Craven (12th June)

2.1.1 Attendance: 23

2.1.2 Actions agreed::

- Probation Service Graffiti removal in Wolston to be followed up
- Safer Neighbourhoods Police Team to prioritise tackling anti-social behaviour in Wolston, and off-road Bikes in Brandon Wood

2.2 Dunchurch (13th June)

2.2.1 Attendance: 26

2.2.2 Actions agreed:

- Crime statistics to be e-mailed to every Parish Council in Dunchurch Division
- Delegation from the Panel to meet with Cemex to agree new route for HGV's through villages
- Need for repairs to bridge at Marton – WCC to investigate and report to next meeting

2.3 Brownsover, Benn & Newbold (18th June)

2.3.1 Attendance: 60

2.3.2 Actions agreed:

- Cllr King to hold meeting with invited Murray Road Residents to discuss parking issues
- Outstanding parking issues (across BBN) to be investigated and reported back to next meeting
- Safer Neighbourhoods Police Team to prioritise local resources towards tackling graffiti, mini-motorbikes and enforcing speed limits
- Ian Davis (Rugby Borough Council) to follow up issues around street cleaning and report to next meeting
