5. Rugby Borough Consolidated Traffic Regulation Order 2006, Proposed Variation Number Three

The report of the Strategic Director of Environment and Economy.

Proposals for various changes to the parking Consolidation Order for Rugby Borough were advertised on 24 August 2007. This report discusses the objections received and recommends that with the exception of the proposals set out in the main body of this report, the variation be implemented as advertised. Members are also asked to confirm the action that they require in relation to the proposal for partial footway parking for King Edward Road, Rugby.

6. A428 Crick Road, Hillmorton, Rugby - Proposed 40 mph and 30 mph Speed Limits

The report of the Strategic Director of Environment and Economy.

Following formal advertisement of the proposed 40 mph and 30 mph speed limit on A428 Crick Road, Hillmorton, Rugby, one objection from the Police has been received.

Associated engineering measures include the provision of vehicle activated signs including interactive chevrons and red surfacing.

This report considers the objection and recommends that the 40 mph and 30 mph speed limits should be implemented as advertised.

Recommendation:

That the 40 mph and 30 mph speed limits should be implemented on A428 Crick Road, Hillmorton, Rugby as advertised.
