# Conversion of Two Lengths of Footway into Shared use Footway/Cycleway - Alcester

## Report of the Strategic Director of Environment and Economy

#### Recommendation

That Area Committee approves the conversion of two lengths of footway alongside Birmingham Road, and B4089 Kinwarton Farm Road, Alcester, to shared use footway/cycleway, as shown on **Appendices A and B**.

## 1. Background

- 1.1 The County Council is working in partnership with Advantage Alcester (who are sponsored by the Regional Development Agency, Advantage West Midlands) to develop a network of cycle routes within Alcester. The cycle routes have been designed in response to public requests for improved cycle facilities identified by the Market Town Initiative health check. The proposals formalise the current footway use but with improved facilities. A number of these routes will require the conversion of sections of footway alongside carriageways into shared use footways/cycleways. Where shared use has been chosen it is because there is no alternative available due to lack of carriageway width or unsuitable speed limit conditions. All proposals comply with recommendations for footway conversion to shared use and meet Safety Audit recommendations.
- 1.2 The County Council is able to effect such improvements using statutory powers under Section 65 of the Highways Act 1980, after obtaining a resolution from the relevant Area Committee.

## 2. Conversion of footway alongside B4089, Kinwarton Farm Road, Alcester

2.1 This will involve an approximately 500 metre length of footway alongside the eastern side of the carriageway (see plan in **Appendix A**). The cycle route will then cross Captains Hill and cross the existing verge between the carriageway and the service road, which will also be shared use. The cycleway will then run on the service road.



## 3. Conversion of footway alongside Birmingham Road, Alcester

3.1 This will involve an approximately 500 metre length of footway with some widening, from the entrance to the Grammar School playing field and Pavilion to the roundabout where the B4035 and Birmingham Road meet the A435. (see plan in **Appendix B**)


### 4. Proposals

4.1 As a part of the Area Committee's powers to determine road traffic management and accident prevention schemes, the Committee is asked to approve the conversion of sections of footways to shared use footway/cycleway facilities, pursuant to Sections 64 and 65 of the Highways Act 1980.


