5. D5005 Malthouse Lane and D5008 Earlswood Lakes Causeway, Earlswood Common - Proposed Extension of 30 mph Speed Limit

Report of the Interim Strategic Director of Environment and Economy.

Following formal advertisement of the proposed regularisation and extension of the existing 30 mph speed limit on the D5005 Malthouse Lane and D5008 Earlswood Lakes Causeway, Earlswood, eight letters of objection were received.

Associated engineering measures include 30 mph speed limit signs on Malthouse Lane and at both ends of the Earlswood Lakes Causeway at its junction with Valley Road.

This report considers the objections and recommends that the 30 mph speed limit should be implemented as advertised.

Recommendation:

That the extension of 30 mph speed limit for D5005 Malthouse Lane and the new 30 mph limit on the D5008 the Earlswood Lakes Causeway should be implemented as advertised.

6. E5998 Stoat Lane, Great Alne - A Petition Requesting Mechanically Propelled Vehicles (except farm traffic) be Prohibited

Report of the Interim Strategic Director of Environment and Economy.

A petition signed by 245 people requires the County Council to prevent Mechanically Propelled Vehicles (except farm traffic) from using Stoat Lane, a non-tarmac surfaced road that lies to the north of Great Alne. It is considered that the grounds cited on the petition do not justify such action and it is therefore recommended that the petitioners' request be refused.

Recommendation:

That the petitioners' requests to prevent mechanically propelled vehicles (except farm traffic) from Stoat Lane be refused. The grounds cited on the petition are not considered sufficient to justify closing the road to such traffic.
