Barford Parish Plan

Report of the Strategic Director of Performance & Development

Recommendation

That the committee welcomes the publication of the Barford Parish Plan and request appropriate County Council Departments to engage with the Barford Parish Plan Committee over those elements of the plan that relate to the services and responsibilities of the County Council.

1.0 The Parish Appraisal / Parish Plan Process

At its meeting in July 2005, this committee approved a protocol for the engagement of County Councillors and County Council departments in the production of Parish Plans and appraisals, and identified the way in which the County Council should respond to plans / appraisals once produced.

2.0 Parish Appraisals and Plans

A Parish Appraisal takes a detailed look at life in a Parish. The appraisal is devised and conducted by local residents, creating a snapshot of community life at a point in time. Often the information obtained in the Parish Appraisal process is then used as a foundation for a Parish Plan, which helps to highlighting local needs and aspirations, enabling the Parish Council to devise an action plan for the short to medium term.

3.0 Barford Parish Plan

Barford Parish Plan Committee has now completed a Parish Plan for Barford which has been approved by the Parish Council (Appendix 1). Warwick Area Committee is asked to formally welcome the publication of the plan and request appropriate County Council Departments to engage with the Barford Parish Plan Committee over those elements of the plan that relate to the services and responsibilities of the County Council.
